A Word from *Love Inc...*

Dear Friends,

Happy Thanksgiving. Got your attention ☺ Love INC is part of the free Thanksgiving Dinner held every year on Thanksgiving Day at The Salvation Army on 4th ST. They generally serve 150-200 people including delivery. All are welcome. It is not too early to consider a donation to help support this great need. Please put Thanksgiving in memo on your check and send to Love INC PO Box 6090 Chillicothe, OH 45601.

Love Inc's operating hours are Tuesday and Thursday 10 am – 1pm. Love Inc helps Ross county residents who qualify with electric, water or gas disconnects. We have a furniture ministry including appliances for those in need. Donations are ALWAYS needed. We also have a partner church that helps with Paper Pantry (cleaning supplies and toiletries). You can refer clients to call 740-773-0239. Every message call is returned.

Here are the stats for the month of AUGUST we had 125 phone messages that we returned and of those there were 95 clients we took phone logs, (which means we completed an intake) and of those we had 55 requests that we were able to meet. Thanks to our partner churches as well as Love INC who pledged a total of \$3021 to meet these needs directly. Our agency also participates in the Dollar Energy program through AEP for clients who qualify. The program paid \$5426 in AUGUST.

WE ARE IN NEED OF FOOD DONATIONS. OUR PANTRY IS GETTING BUSIER EACH MONTH. YOU CAN ALSO SEND A CHECK AND PUT FOOD PANTRY IN MEMO.

Love Inc has a food pantry on the last Saturday of every month 10 am – 12:30. We served a total of 55 households in the month of AUGUST consisting of 31 Seniors, 87 Adults and 78 children for a total of 196 people. Clients need to bring ID and utility bill to prove Ross Co residency. Please spread the word! Thanks, we also will help throughout the month but clients can only come once a month. :)

Please send me the hours that you put in for Love INC for the month of **AUGUST**. It is important information for our quarterly and annual reports. If you could, also include the number of separate contacts the time represents.

Also include any other church volunteers for Love INC and their hours as well. For example, if two volunteers made a home visit and were there two hours, each volunteer would count the two hours as time spent for Love INC (for a total of 4 hours). Remember to count your time on the phone also, at least 15 minutes per call.

Thanks for your attention to this reporting. Your time is very valuable to us, and we appreciate you and your efforts more than you can know.
