LAY SERVANT MINISTRY SPRING CLASSES REGISTRATION IS OPEN

Lay Servant Ministry is our United Methodist system for lay leadership development and includes lay speaking as one of the certifications. The basic and advanced courses are designed to help develop skills in witnessing to the Christian faith through spoken communication, church and community leadership, and care-giving ministries. Specific coursework is required to become a lay speaker, if desired.

These courses are offered to anyone who has a desire to develop leadership skills and learn more about the United Methodist Church.



March 16, 2019

REGISTRATION DEADLINE IS MARCH 1)

- **BASIC COURSE:** This course is foundational for all courses in lay servant ministries. Participants are encouraged to discover and employ personal spiritual gifts as God intended and to consider the importance of exercising servant leadership, developing future leaders, remaining rooted in consistent spiritual practices, and being part of a group that holds members accountable in their discipleship. **The course is taught by Certified Lay Speakers from around the District.**
- **GOD'S MISSION ... OUR JOURNEY:** This course will provide participants with a better understanding of a holistic approach to participation in God's mission to the world and equip lay servants for more effective missional engagement in their communities and beyond. **This course will be led by Rev. Brent Watson and Rev. Beverly Hume.**

April 6, 2019

(REGISTRATION DEADLINE IS MARCH 22)

- **DISCOVER YOUR SPIRITUAL GIFTS:** This course helps participants understand spiritual gifts and how the church can use them to fulfill its mission and ministry. Participants will also learn what it means to be a spiritual leader and will be equipped to lead others in exploring and using their spiritual gifts. **This course will be taught by Rev. Janie Karl.**

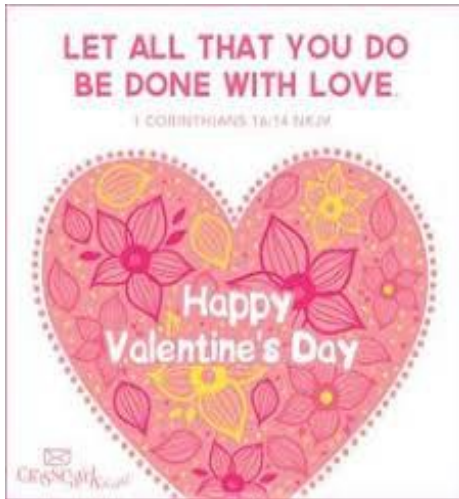
