Time Change



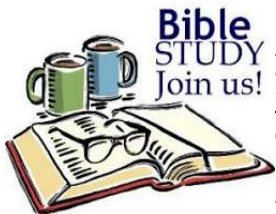

A reminder that the church sanctuary will be available from 10:30 am to noon every Monday morning for anyone who wants to pray for someone in need or to pray for their own needs. Of course you can go to God in prayer anywhere, but if you need to get away from the hustle and bustle of your daily life and settle in a neutral quiet place, our sanctuary will be open. There will be a list of prayer requests laying on the altar if you wish to pray for others. Prayer is a vital instrument in our christian life. God wants to hear from us. Philippians 4:6 tells us, "Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God."




Tithes and Offerings

If you haven't already noticed, we have changed the way we are collecting the tithes and offerings. Instead of passing plates through the pews, we have placed boxes at both entrances to the sanctuary.

There will always be plenty of pew envelopes to use if you are not using specific tithing envelopes. If you give cash make sure that you put your name on the envelope so your information can be recorded for your tax purposes. Thank you for supporting our church and it's ministries!



I know that I have mentioned this several times, but I would love to see more of our church family sign into REALM. It's our web based Church Management Software system. It is used primarily by staff, but offers the congregation the opportunity to control their own information such as name change, change of address, new phone numbers, etc. I have sent out several emails prompting a response to sign up. Realm for Tyler is used specifically by those who attend here and no one else. It is not open to the public. You can sign up with any computer, tablet, or phone. Once an account is established you can get the free app for your phone or tablet. It will be called Realm Connect. Even if you don't use a smart phone you can still access the church directory using your desktop computer or laptop. If you have the app for your phone, you can look up anyone in the church and have access to their phone number to call them, or an address to send them a card. It's no different than the hard copy church manual that we put out. You can even email them through Realm. Another option for using Realm is you can set up automatic gifts and offerings, one time or recurring weekly, monthly, whatever you like. It's very convenient to just make a donation from the pew using the app. You can keep track of your own giving and print your own end of the year statement if you choose. Postings about what is going on at the church, group chats and other events are on Realm. Any questions, please just give me a call or catch me at church! Kathy Arbaugh 740-773-1270.
