Interested in becoming certified for disaster response?

The eight hour Basic Class training will teach you how to assist survivors of natural disasters in their time of need. You will provide a Christian presence while taking steps to prevent further damage to a family's personal property, tarping, debris removal, cleaning out flooded homes, etc. FEMA recognizes this training to be able to enter a disaster scene. Certification from UMCOR and UMVIM will be issued to attendees. Class instructor is Roger Thatcher. A four hour re-certification class will also be offered for those needing re-certification.

NOTE: A background check is required to receive an ERT badge from UMCOR. You will receive a link to run a background check with UMCOR when you register online, please complete the background check prior to the class.

Basic certification \$40 (includes lunch); Re-certification \$35 w/lunch or \$25 w/o lunch.
